Angel Moroni on the London Temple spire



To celebrate the 50th anniversary of the dedication of The London Temple in Newchapel in 2008 a 7 feet high gold clad statue of the Angel Moroni has been installed on the 180 feet high copper clad spire.

Aluminium scaffolding, used to limit applied loads on the roof and tower structure was erected to adapt the existing spire frame which is fitted with a new copper clad cone cap.

The glassfibre statue, shipped from the United States was finally set in position by helicopter.
